Dear Sirs:-


We are enclosing two copies of the Company's Report-Form No. 5, in order that you may report business transacted in Puerto Rico during calendar year 1957.

All fire and casualty companies are required to fill in the Exhibit of Premiums and Losses appearing on page 14 of the Annual Statement Blank.

Please be informed that in accordance with Circular Letter 7-135-56, dated July 30, 1956, premiums and losses on tornado, cyclone and windstorm shall be presented as a major risk item under hurricane in your reports to this Office.

You are reminded that the filing date of both statements the Company's Report and the Annual Statement of the Company for the year 1957, is due on March 31, 1958 and must be received in this Office on or before that date.
