Circular Letter No. 3-185-58
March 7, 1958

TO ALL GENERAL AGENTS, INSURANCE COMPANIES,
AND RATING ORGANIZATIONS LICENSED IN PUERTO RICO

Gentlemen:

The Puerto Rico Insurance Code that became effective on January 1, 1958 provides in its Section 11.140 that every policy for delivery in Puerto Rico shall be offered in English or in Spanish. It also provides that the policy forms to be used in Puerto Rico shall be previously approved by the Commissioner of Insurance of this Commonwealth.

This Office hereby grants you until June 30, 1958 within which time you shall file for our approval in both languages the policy forms being used on March 31, 1958 if you wish to continue using them.

Said policy forms shall be submitted with a transmittal letter in duplicate indicating the number and title of the forms.

On the other hand, every policy form submitted for our approval and received in this Office after March 31, 1958 shall be filed both in English and in Spanish. For this you shall follow the instructions contained in Rule XXIV of the Regulation that became effective on January 15, 1958.
