ACCIDENT AND HEALTH INSURANCE IN PUERTO RICO


Gentlemen:

Reference is made to our Circular Letter # A-8-237 dated August 12, 1959, requesting certain information regarding Accident & Health Insurance in our Commonwealth. *con resp*

It has come to our attention the fact that the average number of individual policies in force during calendar year 1958 reported by your company is the same as the actual or estimated number of persons covered under these policies. That is, each individual policy was reported as covering one person only, which in general is not the case in A & H insurance.

Since the accuracy of these figures is of great importance to the study concerning Hospital and Medical Services that our Department of Health is conducting, we will appreciate your checking the figures reported for individual accident and health insurance and inform us whether those figures are the correct ones. If more accurate figures are available, we will appreciate your reporting the corresponding corrections. *Approved*
