TO ALL FIRE, MARINE, CASUALTY AND MISCELLANEOUS
INSURANCE COMPANIES DOING BUSINESS IN PUERTO RICO

Dear Sirs:

Enclosed please, find blank forms for the filing of your windstorm insurance experience, if such type of insurance was transacted during calendar year 1966. This report must be completed in their entirety and filed with this office in addition to the convention annual statement and must be received in this office on or before March 31, 1967.


The filing of the Insurance Expense Exhibit is due on May 1, 1967. We do not supply the form for the filing of the Insurance Expense Exhibit.

The annual statement must be filed in the official form approved by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners for the year 1966.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 3.310(2) of our Insurance Code, foreign insurers not organized in the United States, which elect to file an annual statement relating to their United States business must file all that information pertaining to their Puerto Rico affairs and transactions. This must include the information required on page 14 of the convention annual statement with respect to Puerto Rico business and information pertaining to transactions and holding of investments in Puerto Rico securities as of December 31, 1966, in the manner required in the convention annual statement. It is of utmost importance that this information be filed with the convention annual statement and within the filing due date.

Also enclosed is the form of statement of reconciliation of premiums received for Puerto Rico business to be filed concurrently with the annual statement.
