THIS OFFICE


Gentlemen:

Section 9.270(2) of the Puerto Rico Insurance Code provides that a nonresident agent or broker "may place insurance upon subjects located or to be performed in Puerto Rico only through a resident agent or broker of Puerto Rico, and in an insurer authorized to transact insurance in Puerto Rico. The insurance so transacted shall be deemed, for all purposes, as being transacted in Puerto Rico". (Emphasis added)

Please inform us the name of the resident agent or broker of Puerto Rico through whom you are placing the business procured under your nonresident agent's or broker's license in compliance with the above quoted provision.
