Circular Letter No.S-11-659-75

TO ALL INSURERS AUTHORIZED TO TRANSACT LIFE AND
DISABILITY INSURANCE IN PUERTO RICO

Gentlemen:

Act No. 98, approved June 5, 1973, amended Section 11.140(2) of the Insurance Code of Puerto Rico so as to require that every policy issued for delivery in Puerto Rico shall be offered written in Spanish and shall be issued in the English language at the policyholder's request.


To comply therewith, a period of three years was given to those insurers whose policies did not meet the requirements of Section 11.140(2), as amended. Said period will expire on June 5, 1976.

As mentioned in our Circular Letter No. S-6-648-75 issued previously this year, all translated forms will have first to be filed with and approved by the Commissioner before their issuance and delivery in Puerto Rico, pursuant to the provisions of Section 11.110 of our Insurance Code.

In view of the above, we would appreciate if you could inform us, within the next 15 days, what progress has been made as of this date and what steps are being taken by your company to eventually comply with the aforementioned provision.

Thank you for the cooperation you can give us in this matter.
