Dear Sirs:


We recently sent you Circular Letter No. AM-I-3-699-77 dated March 28, 1977, requesting a monthly report of all medical, dental and hospital malpractice claims received during each month, to be reported in the blank form supplied by this Office.

We are hereby amending Circular Letter No. AM-I-3-699-77 of March 28, 1977, as follows:

1. Companies or brokers not engaged at present in the writing of Physicians, Surgeons and Dentists and Hospital Malpractice Insurance should notify so to this Office in a letter of transmittal and no further reports are to be submitted. As soon as the companies or brokers become thereafter involved in the writing of such lines of insurance they must submit the requested report.
2. Companies actually engaged in the writing of such lines of insurance and not receiving any claim during a particular month may comply with Circular Letter AM-I-3-699-77 of March 28, 1977, by a letter of transmittal stating that no claim has been received during that month. Only companies or brokers actually engaged in the writing of such business and receiving one or more claim during a particular month must complete the blank form furnished by this Office.

Strict compliance with the aforementioned amendmet is hereby required.
