TO ALL NONRESIDENT INSURANCE BROKERS AND
AGENTS LICENSED TO DO BUSINESS IN PUERTO RICO

Gentlemen:

Please be advised that, pursuant to Rule XV(3) of the Regulations of the Puerto Rico Insurance Code, you are required to furnish a report of all the business transacted under your nonresident license for calendar year 1980.


Said report must be received in our Office on or before March 31, 1981. To be sure that you file it on time, please send it to us as soon as you have it completed.

Under the column Insurer in which it was Placed, inform the exact name of the insurance company in which business was placed. If the insurer belongs to a group, it is not sufficient to inform the name of the group, as not all the insurers in the group may be authorized to transact business in Puerto Rico.

Enclosed are two copies of a form for your compliance with this requirement. Please send us the original and keep a copy for your records. BE SURE TO COMPLETE EACH COLUMN.

We are also enclosing our Circular Letter No. LE-1-830-81 containing full instructions for the renewal of your license for fiscal year 1981-82.
