TO THE RATING AND ADVISORY ORGANIZATIONS LICENSED BY THIS OFFICE

Gentlemen:

Your present license will expire at midnight June 30, 1984.

Sections 12.210 and 12.350 of the Insurance Code of Puerto Rico provide respectively that licenses of all rating and advisory organizations will expire on June 30 of each year and may be renewed annually on payment of the license fee.


The fee for each license, according to Section 7.010 of the Insurance Code of Puerto Rico, is as follows:

Rating Bureau	\$200
Advisory Organization	\$100

If you wish to renew your license, please send us, not later than April 16, 1984, a check in the corresponding amount, as above indicated, payable to the Secretary of the Treasury of Puerto Rico, enclosing also, a pre-paid self-stamped pre-addressed envelope.

The new license shall be mailed to you by the end of June 1984.
