Subject: Approval of Rule LIV
of the Regulations of
the Insurance Code of
Puerto Rico

Dear Sirs:

Rule LIV of the Regulations of the Insurance Code of Puerto Rico shall become effective on June 14, 1984.

The purpose of the approved rule is to establish pursuant to Act. No. 66 of May 27, 1976, as amended, the fees to be paid to the Secretary of the Treasury by every person, rating bureau, insurer or health maintenance organization making or presenting a filing with the Commissioner of Insurance of any basic insurance policy form, application form, printed rider, endorsement form, rate manual, schedule of rates, classification of risks, rating plans, and any other information concerning the application and calculation of rates which are subject to prior approval pursuant to Sections 11.110, 12.050, 12.040 and 19.180 of the Insurance Code of Puerto Rico.

The failure to pay, at the time of submission of the filing, the fees prescribed by said Rule shall be considered as a ground for the disapproval of such filing.


