Movement


Dear Sirs:

On May 30, 1987, at approximately 1:55 p.m., an earth movement, whose center was located between the region of La Parguera and the municipality of Lajas occurred in Puerto Rico. The news media estimated the losses in an amount near \$300,000.

This Office is very much interested in gathering information concerning the losses caused by such an uncommon phenomenon. To this effect, and pursuant to the provisions of section 3.320 of the Insurance Code of Puerto Rico, we are enclosing a blank form in which specific information regarding claims under insurance applicable to such losses must be included by you.

The requested information must be submitted to this Office not later than October 31, 1987. If no claims were received, please state so in the form. No insurer is exempted from completing said form.

Strict compliance with the provisions of this Circular Letter is hereby required.
