Dear Sirs:


On September 18, 1989, Hurricane Hugo hit Puerto Rico. The news media estimated the losses in billions of dollars.

To this effect and pursuant to the provisions of section 3.320 of the Insurance Code of Puerto Rico, we are enclosing a blank form in which specific information regarding claims under insurance applicable to such losses must be included by you.

The requested information must be submitted to this Office not later than January 15, 1990. If no claims were received, please state so in the form. No insurer is exempted from completing said form.
