hurricane Hugo in Puerto Rico

Dear Sirs:


Section 3.320 of the Insurance Code of Puerto Rico, 26 LPRA sec. 332, stipulates the following:

"Each authorized insurer shall, at the request of the Commissioner, furnish or cause to be furnished to the Commissioner data for compilation and study of statistics relative to insurance of such insurer effected or in force in Puerto Rico. Such data may include information as to losses suffered on account of any risk or risks, cause of such losses, and other information deemed necessary by the Commissioner."

Pursuant to the aforesaid section, this Office is hereby requesting that every property and casualty insurer authorized to transact insurance business in Puerto Rico submit a complete report of the claims paid in relation with Hurricane Hugo as of February 28, 1990. This information must be submitted to this Office on or before April 3, 1990.

Strict compliance with the aforesaid provisions is hereby required. Remember, the fault to submit on time said information is cause sufficient to impose penalties to the insurer.
