
Section 3.320 of the Insurance Code of Puerto Rico, 26 LPRA Sec. 332, stipulates the following:

"Each authorized insurer shall, at the request of the Commissioner, furnish of cause to be furnished to the Commissioner data for compilation and study of statistics relative to insurance of such insurer effected or in force in Puerto Rico. Such data may include information as to losses suffered on account of any risk or risks, cause of such losses, and other information deemed necessary by the Commissioner."

Pursuant to the aforesaid section, this Office is hereby requesting that every property and casualty reinsurer authorized in Puerto Rico submit a complete report of the claims paid to insurers in Puerto Rico in relation to Hurricane Hugo catastrophe of September 18, 1989. This information must be submitted to this Office on or before November 30, 1990 and will cover claims paid up to October 31, 1990. Be advised that the report requested shall be filed even if no claims were received or paid.

Strict compliance with the aforesaid provisions is hereby required. Remember, failure to submit said information on time is sufficient cause to impose penalties.
