TO ALL INSURERS AND TO ALL GENERAL AGENTS AND MANAGERS  
OF FOREIGN INSURERS DOING BUSINESS IN PUERTO RICO

Re: Renewal of certificate of  
authority for 1991-92

Dear People:

Section 3.190 of the Insurance Code of Puerto Rico provides that all certificates of authority issued to insurers shall expire at midnight June 30 each year, and if the insurer qualifies therefor its certificate may be renewed for a period of not more than one year.

In those cases where an insurer is represented by more than one general agent or manager, it shall decide and indicate who will request the renewal.

If any other general agent or manager of said insurer wishes a copy of said certificate of authority he must request the same from our Office.

In order for this Office to renew your 1992-93 certificate of authority by July 1, 1992, please send us, not later than March 30, 1992, a letter requesting the renewal, enclosing a pre-stamped and pre-addressed small (12" x 9") manila paper envelope.

The new certificate of authority shall be mailed to you by the end of June 1992.
