**Re: Extension granted for the renewal of motor vehicle licenses**

Ladies and Gentlemen:

On account of the damages caused by Hurricane Georges, an extension has been granted for the renewal of motor vehicle licenses and the obtention of the corresponding stickers (marbetes), to those motor vehicle owners whose motor vehicle licenses expired during the past month of September and still have not been renewed. This extension will grant said motor vehicle owners an additional one month, until October 30, 1998, to comply with the motor vehicle license renewal requirement, without being subject to any penalty.

In view of the above, compulsory liability insurance coverage in force as of September 30, 1998, must be continued during the extension period.
