TO ALL FOREIGN INSURERS


Subject: Renewal of certificate of authority for fiscal year 2000-2001

Sirs:

Section 7.010 of the Insurance Code of Puerto Rico establishes, as a condition to continue to be authorized to solicit or transact any kind of insurance in Puerto Rico, that the persons or entities so authorized shall pay, not later than June 30th of each year, a single annual contribution.

Considering the above, and in accordance with Section 7.010(1)(e) of the aforesaid Code, the annual contribution to be paid by each foreign insurer shall be \$6,000.00. To this effect, and in order that said certificate of authority be renewed as of July 1, 2000, it is necessary that the enclosed form be completed and sent to our Office before May 31, 2000, together with a check or money order for said amount, payable to the Secretary of Treasury, and a pre-addressed small (12" x 9") manila paper envelope.

Strict compliance with the provisions of this circular letter is hereby required.
