**TO ALL INSURERS AUTHORIZED TO
TRANSACTION VEHICLE INSURANCE IN PUERTO RICO
(Official English Translation)**

Re: Information on insureds and vehicles covered under personal and commercial automobile policies, that must be obtained by insurers to facilitate the coordination of traditional liability insurance and compulsory liability insurance

Ladies and Gentlemen:

As you know, Act No. 253 of December 27, 1995, establishes a compulsory liability insurance program applicable to motor vehicles that travel on our public roadways and imposes on the Commissioner of Insurance the responsibility of overseeing the observance and compliance of its provisions, and specifically of achieving a fair and efficient coordination between traditional liability insurance and compulsory liability insurance.

To this effect, in our communication of January 7, 1997, we requested that all insurers authorized to transact vehicle insurance in Puerto Rico, send to each one of their insureds under either personal or commercial traditional liability insurance policies, a copy of the "Questionnaire Regarding Information Needed for Compliance with the Motor Vehicle Compulsory Liability Insurance Act". Together with said form, a copy of the message from the Commissioner of Insurance to the insureds explaining the purpose of the requested information and exhorting the insureds to comply with this requirement had to be sent.


Considering the importance of obtaining the aforesaid information, we are hereby requesting those insurers authorized to transact vehicle insurance in Puerto Rico, to follow up to the insureds who have not provided said information, in order to obtain the same.

We would also like to take this opportunity to stress that the information requirement includes the obtention of data pertaining to vehicles not listed in commercial traditional liability insurance policies.
