TO ALL AUTOMOBILE CLUBS DOING BUSINESS IN PUERTO RICO

2004 ANNUAL STATEMENT

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

Section 21.200 of the Insurance Code of Puerto Rico, 26 L.P.R.A. stipulates the following:


“Every automobile club or association shall file in the Office of the Commissioner, on or before March 31 of each year, a financial statement in the form and manner prescribed by the Commissioner, signed under oath by its president or one of its principal officers, showing its financial condition as of the preceding December 31.”

Pursuant to the aforesaid section, the annual statement for the calendar year ending December 31, 2004, must be filed in this Office **on or before March 31, 2005**.

Also, the automobile club must include a schedule indicating the direct business of the automobile club in Puerto Rico, signed under oath by one of its principal officers, including the premiums or quotas written and unearned, and losses paid and unpaid. If no business was written for said period, it must be also indicated in said schedule.

Strict compliance with the above is hereby required.
