TO ALL FOREIGN DISABILITY INSURERS AND HEALTHCARE MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS AUTHORIZED TO SUSCRIBE HEALTH INSURANCE IN PUERTO RICO

REQUEST FOR INFORMATION REGARDING THE NUMBER OF PERSONS WERE BENEFICIARIES OF A HEALTHCARE PLAN AND DIAGNOSED WITH SPECIAL HEALTH NEEDS BETWEEN THE AGES OF 0 A 21 YEARS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2004

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

The Division of Habilitative Services of the Department of Health of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico ("the Department") is in the process of compiling information regarding the number of persons that were beneficiaries of a healthcare plan and were diagnosed with special health needs between the ages of 0 to 21 years as of December 31, 2004.

The Department has requested the collaboration of the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance of Puerto Rico ("OCI") in obtaining said information from those disability insurers and health maintenance organizations that are authorized to subscribe health insurance in Puerto Rico.


For these reasons, all insurers and health maintenance organizations that subscribe health insurance are hereby required to submit this statistical information. It is requested to compliment and submit this report to OCI **in or before Friday, April 22, 2005**. The required report to be filled out and sent is at www.ocs.gobierno.pr/PDF/exppub/c_norm_Anejo_n-es-4-64-2005. This report must be saved in Excel format as 2004NE_F_NC. The "NC" is the code given by NAIC to the insurer. To expedite the process, the email must include the name of the file in the

subject line and send it to estadisticas@ocs.gobierno.pr. In addition, a hard copy of this report must be sent by regular mail to OCI.
