RULING LETTER NO.: 2009-98-PR

TO ALL LOCAL INSURERS, ALL GENERAL AGENTS AND MANAGERS OF FOREIGN INSURERS AND ALL PRODUCERS, AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES, CONSULTANTS, AND AUTHORIZED ADJUSTERS IN PUERTO RICO

Re: Amendment to paragraph 4(a) of Ruling Letter N-C-A-10-119-2000

Dear Sirs and Madams:

On October 20, 2000, Ruling Letter N-C-A-10-119-2000 was issued, hereinafter the "Ruling Letter," to address several issues in Rule 70 of the Puerto Rico Insurance Code Regulations.

With a view to providing a broader offering of activities available for fulfilling the continuous education requirements provided for herein, further to a thorough analysis, we have found it advisable to accept courses that are taken for maintaining the professional titles mentioned in paragraph 4(a) of the aforementioned Ruling Letter.

Therefore, we have decided to amend paragraph 4(a) of the Ruling Letter as follows:


- "4. The following are acceptable activities for fulfilling continuous education requirements:
 - a. The following segments leading to professional designations that are recognized and approved by the Commissioner, as well as continuous education courses required to maintain such in effect, such as the designations granted by the following entities, whether or not the licensee has approved said segments prior to the effective date of this Rule:

- i. American Educational Institute
- ii. American Institute for Chartered Property and Casualty Underwriters
- iii. Casualty Actuarial Society
- iv. Health Insurance Association of America
- v. Insurance Institute of America
- vi. International Foundation of Employee Benefits
- vii. Life Office Management Association
- viii. Life Underwriter Training Council
- ix. Professional Liability Underwriting Association
- x. The American College
- xi. The National Alliance for Insurance Education & Research

In order to receive credit for the activities directed at maintaining designations under paragraph 4 (a), the licensee shall submit to the Producer Services Division an original official certification from the institution that issues the professional designation, showing that the participant completed the course and the contact hours to be credited.

Strict compliance with the provisions of this Ruling Letter is required.
