TO ALL INSURERS THAT WRITE PROPERTY AND CASUALTY INSURANCE IN
PUERTO RICO

**EXTENSION OF EXPIRATION DATE OF AUTOMOBILE REGISTRATION
STICKERS**

Dear Sirs and Madams:

The Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTOP), has notified us that the service provided by the Driver Services Centers has been affected by a failure in the electronic system which has meant that services are being offered in a limited manner. Given that situation it became imperative for the DTOP to extend the expiration date for licenses up to December 8, 2012.

So that service to the public will not be affected it is necessary to allow the insured of the Compulsory Liability Insurance Joint Underwriting Association, as well as those of the traditional insurers, who for that reason were not able to renew their registration stickers during the period in which the DTOP system failed, may do so in the next few days without affecting their coverage under Compulsory Liability Insurance for those days.

We are hereby reiterating the official position of this Office that this action does not constitute a violation in any manner of the provisions of the Puerto Rico Insurance Code or its Regulations.
