**TO ALL HEALTH INSURANCE ORGANIZATIONS AND INSURERS THAT  
PROVIDE PHARMACY COVERAGE IN HEALTH INSURANCE**

**RE: REQUIREMENT ON INFORMATION ON COST AND USE OF  
PRESCRIBED MEDICATIONS**

The Department of Consumer Affairs (DACO) is engaged in reviewing and updating regulations on the sales prices of medicinal products, under the powers vested in the Department under Public Laws No. 5, enacted on April 23, 1973 and No. 228, enacted on May 12, 1942, as amended.

To that effect, DACO has requested the collaboration of our agency to gather from health insurance organizations and insurers that offer pharmacy coverage in the private health insurance sector information on the cost and use of the top ten (10) brand and generic medications of the highest cost and use under pharmacy coverage during 2016.t

In view of the above, all health insurance organizations and insurers that offer pharmacy coverage in the private health insurance sector are required to submit the requested information using the table that is enclosed with this Circular Letter to the following email address, [apoyo@ocs.pr.gov](mailto:apoyo@ocs.pr.gov), on or before Monday, **September 11, 2017**.
