**CIRCULAR LETTER NO.: CC-2017-1917-ES**

**TO ALL INSURERS AUTHORIZED TO TRANSACT PROPERTY AND CONTINGENCY INSURANCE IN PUERTO RICO**

**STATISTICS ON HURRICANE MARIA**

Dear Sirs and Madams:

In order to compile reliable statistics, the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance of Puerto Rico (hereinafter, the OCI) and FEMA, are gathering information on claims for losses and private flood insurance claims arising from the impact of the Hurricane María in Puerto Rico<sup>1</sup>.

For this purpose and pursuant to the provisions of Section 3.320 of the Insurance Code of Puerto Rico, all insurers that are authorized to transact property and casualty insurance in Puerto Rico shall submit the information contained in the forms titled **“Summary of Losses Claimed in Puerto Rico as Result of Hurricane María”** and **“Insurance Claims Data.”**

All property and hazard insurers shall file both forms on or before November 17, 2017, and they shall include the information on claims up to October 31, 2017. With regard to the months of November and December of 2017, the forms shall be filed monthly at our Office, by the fifteenth (15th) of the following month. From 2018 on, insurers will be required to submit cumulative information quarterly in an itemized manner on the forms, on the fifteenth (15th) day of the month following each quarter, until all the claims area liquidated.

The official forms are also available on our web page at: [www.ocs.pr.gov](http://www.ocs.pr.gov). If you did not receive any claims, you should state so on the form. No insurer is exempted from completing the forms or providing this information.
