TO ALL INSURERS THAT ARE AUTHORIZED TO TRANSACT PROPERTY AND CASUALTY INSURANCE IN PUERTO RICO

AMENDMENT TO RULING LETTER CN-2018-233-D: 2020 FILING OF THE “PR INSURANCE DATA COLLECTION REPORT FOR HURRICANE MARÍA” FOR COMPILING STATISTICAL DATA ON CLAIMS RESULTING FROM HURRICANE MARÍA

Dear Sirs and Madams:

In Ruling Letter No. CN-2018-233-D, dated January 24, 2018, the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance established, among other matters, that all property and casualty insurers should file the form “PR Insurance Data Collection Report for Hurricane María” on a monthly basis until all claims that were received as a consequence of Hurricane María are liquidated.

Due to the percentage of data that has been gathered in the time that has transpired after the implementation of this report, we have decided to modify the period established in Ruling Letter No. CN-2018-233-D for filing the form “PR Insurance Data Collection Report for Hurricane María” from a monthly to a bi-annual period. Therefore, henceforth the form “PR Insurance Data Collection Report for Hurricane María” must be filed semi-annually on or before (15) days of the month after the closing of the semester. This will be beginning with the January to June 2020 period and the form shall be filed on or before July 15, 2020.

Strict compliance with the provisions of this letter is hereby required. Failure to comply with the guidelines set forth in this ruling letter will entail the imposition of sanctions.
