TO ALL FIRE, MARINE, CASUALTY AND MISCELLANEOUS
INSURANCE COMPANIES DOING BUSINESS IN PUERTO RICO

Dear Sirs:

Enclosed please find blank forms of the Statement of Reconciliation of Premiums Written for Puerto Rico Business. This statement must be completed in its entirety and filed with this Office, in addition to the regular annual statement, before March 31, 1974.

The annual statement must be filed in the official form approved by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 3.310(2) of our Insurance Code, foreign insurers not organized in the United States which elect to file an annual statement relating to their United States business, must file all that information pertaining to their Puerto Rico affairs and transactions.

It is hereby requested that all insurers authorized to do business in the State of Puerto Rico must include the information required on page 14 of the regular annual statement with respect to Puerto Rico business only and information pertaining to transactions and holding of investments in Puerto Rico securities as of December 31, 1973, in the manner prescribed therein. It is of utmost importance that this information be filed with the regular annual statement and within the filing due date.

The filing of the Insurance Expense Exhibit is due on, or before, May 1, 1974. We do not supply the forms for the filing of the Insurance Expense Exhibit.

Also, enclosed is the Statement of Reconciliation of Premiums Written for Puerto Rico Business, to be filed concurrently with the annual statement.

These reports, as well as the regular annual statement, must be submitted in duplicate. Please be advised that no additional time will be granted for the submission of these reports.
