This Office is examining the overall situation regarding the Private Passenger Automobile insurance business in Puerto Rico. We are most interested in clarifying all aspects having to do with the underwriting experience of this line of insurance.

To this effect, and in accordance with the provisions, of article 3.320 of the Insurance Code of Puerto Rico, we are hereby requesting that you submit the following information by coverage on a total limits basis for the calendar years ending December 31, 1971, December 31, 1972 and December 31, 1973.


1. Direct written premiums
2. Direct earned premiums
3. Losses Paid
4. Reserves for outstanding losses
5. Reserves for losses incurred but not reported
6. Allocated loss adjustment expenses
7. Unallocated loss adjustment expenses

The aforementioned information must be submitted to this Office within twenty (20) days after the date of this letter.
