



Circular Letter No. AV-I-8-610-74

TO ALL INSURANCE COMPANIES AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE
ACCIDENT & HEALTH INSURANCE CONTRACTS IN THE
COMMONWEALTH OF PUERTO RICO

The Legislature of Puerto Rico pursuant to Senate Resolution 353 has brought to our attention the fact that certain policies covering hospital and medical expenses exclude benefits provided under Law 138 of June 26, 1968 (ACAA), and that the premium charged has not been adjusted to reflect the decrease in cost on account of this exclusion.

In order that the Commissioner of Insurance can offer adequate proof before November 30, 1974, that such may not be the case, we are hereby requiring that you submit to this Office a list of the plans which exclude such benefits and also the actuarial work in support of the determination of the cost of the insurance to the policyholder, on or before October 31, 1974.
