

RULE VI

CANCELLATION OF A SOLICITOR'S LICENSE

Legal Authority: Sections 9.230 and 9.240

Section 1.-A Solicitor's license shall be cancelled upon request therefor in writing filed with the Commissioner by either the solicitor himself or the agent or broker who named him. If the request for cancellation is by the agent or broker, the request shall be accompanied by proof that notice of such request has likewise been mailed to the solicitor, and no such cancellation shall become effective until after the solicitor, in regular course of mails, should have received the notice. Such request by an agent or broker may state the causes for such cancellation, and information so furnished the commissioner shall be privileged and shall not be used as evidence in any action against the agent or broker or any of their representatives.
